What you should know about PCC:

80 cents of every donated dollar goes for patient services.

\$125 pays for one well-child exam • \$150 pays for one office visit. • \$250 pays for a full course of immunizations from birth to preschool • \$375 pays for nutritional counseling and supplies for a newly diagnosed diabetic • \$550 pays for flu shots for 25 seniors • \$1,201 pays for a full course of prenatal care
