Johnson's desire to make all the records of his administration available to all Americans, and to let them render their own verdict as to his place in history. The library's mission is to preserve and protect historical materials, to increase public awareness of the American experience, and to advance the intellectual activities of the community. Free Congress Avenue Bridge Bats

You'll want to arrive early to get a good spot for viewing. The bats generally come out right after the sun sets, but they could emerge up to 30 minutes before or after. The black cloud of bats is a sight to behold, and there are several places from which you can get a great view:

- Ann W. Richards Congress Avenue Bridge
- Austin-American Statesman Bat Observation Area
- Lady Bird Lake

Bat viewers can park in the Austin-American Statesman parking lot at 305 S. Congress Ave starting at \$6 for 4 hours. Parking is available at the Radisson Hotel & Suites for a per-hour fee. Parking meters in the downtown area are NOT enforced after 6 PM

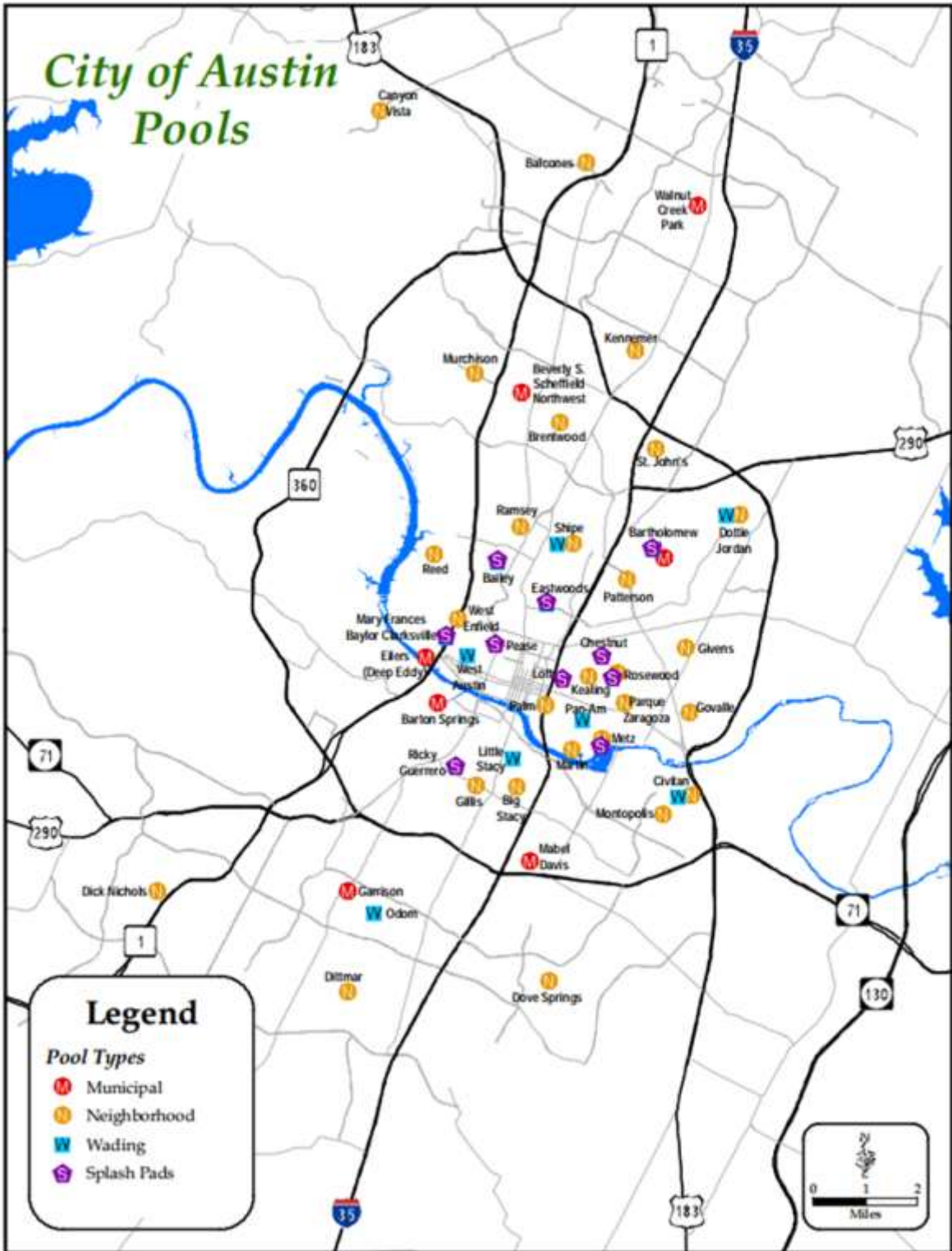

Many pools will close for the summer season on Sunday, August 24. Please check the schedule for your desired pool carefully when making your plans.
