Danger Signs

- Vaginal bleeding (more than small spotting)
- Moderate to severe abdominal or pelvic pain
- Chest pain with difficulty breathing
- Severe headache
- Changes in vision
- Swelling in feet/ankles
- Puffiness or swelling in the face
- Fever of more than 99.6 °F
- Burning when you pee
- Decreased fetal movement after 20 weeks (< 10 movements in 2 hours)
- Five or more uterine contractions in one hour before 36 weeks
- Diarrhea, nausea or vomiting lasting longer than 24 hours
